A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 holidays and observances, so as to include Robert E. Lee's birthday and Confederate
- 3 Memorial Day as public and legal holidays in the State of Georgia; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to holidays and
- 8 observances, is amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 1-4-1, relating to public
- 9 and legal holidays and leave for observance of religious holidays not specifically provided
- 10 for, as follows:
- 11 "(a) The State of Georgia shall recognize and observe as public and legal holidays:
- 12 (1) All days which have been designated as of January 1, 1984, as public and legal
- holidays by the federal government; and
- 14 (2) January 19, for Robert E. Lee's birthday;
- 15 (3) April 26, for Confederate Memorial Day; and
- 16 $\frac{(2)(4)}{(2)}$ All other days designated and proclaimed by the Governor as public and legal
- holidays or as days of fasting and prayer or other religious observance. In such
- designation the Governor shall include at least one of the following dates: January 19,
- 19 April 26, or June 3, or a suitable date in lieu thereof to commemorate the event or events
- 20 now observed by such dates."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
